Khandra, Paschim Bardhaman, 713363 ( henceforth referred to as the First Party) and Shri Sudam Shil, on behalf of Mssrs Rahul Computer Centre, Dakshin Khanda, Paschim Bardhaman, 713363 (henceforth referred to as the Second Party) on the 5<sup>th</sup> day of July 2018 for two ( 02)years, i.e. till the 4<sup>th</sup> day of July, 2020, on the following terms and conditions:

- (1) Understanding the Second Party as a reputed Computer Training Centre in the nearby locality and considering its output, the First party is desirous of getting its students and staff to undergo Training in Computer basics under the guidance and supervision of the Second Party
